The Ella Baker School is part of the Julia Richmond Educational Complex on East 67th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenues in Manhattan. Closest subway stops are the 68th St/Hunter College stop on the 6 line and the 72nd St stop on the Q line (use the downtown-most exit). Bus lines M15 and M66 are also convenient.

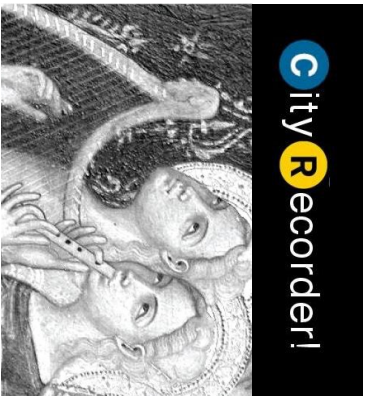
